PURPOSE

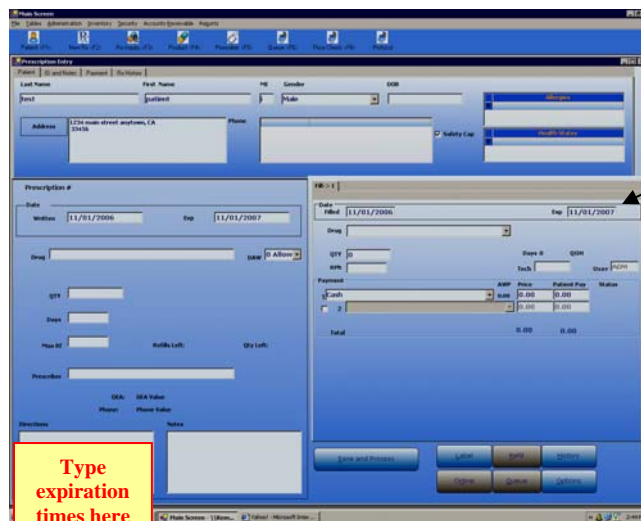
To ensure that all IDS Pharmacists type an expiration date, and time of day, on each IV label at the time of dispensing for electronic auditing purposes.

POLICY

1. **EXPIRATION DATE AND TIME OF DAY ON ALL IVS:** A typed in (not handwritten) expiration date and time of day will be on every IV label at the time of dispensing;
2. **EXPIRATION DATE AND TIME DETERMINED BY SPONSOR STABILITY TESTS & TIME OF COMPOUNDING:** IDS will determine the appropriate expiration date and time for compounded injectable medications based upon stability studies provided by the Sponsor and the date and time that a particular injectable product is compounded.

PROCEDURE

1. **TYPE THE EXPIRATION DATE AND TIME OF DAY:** Prior to dispensing, type in the expiration date and time of day on each IV label and attach to the IV. Enter IV expiration date & time into the Panacea Rx pharmacy software at the following locations:
